



Notice to Residents on Lone Shadow

Repaving Work to Start Soon

This notice is to inform you that the City of Converse Public Works Department and Lone Star Paving will be in your neighborhood for the next few days to complete much needed street resurfacing and repaving work.

Street repaving crews will be doing a mill and asphalt overlay procedure that requires the use of heavy machinery and materials so it is essential that your personal vehicle be removed off the street. When you see orange and black signs that say **REMOVE VEHICLES FROM CURB**--this is warning that the paving work will be done on your street on that particular day. **Any vehicles that are not moved will be towed.** Also, please **Do not water your lawn** when the orange & black signs are on your street. Moisture has an adverse impact on the base material and affects the structure of the pavement work.

After the completion of the typical work day by the paving crew, your street will be opened for vehicle traffic and you will have access to your home. We will try to keep disruptions to a minimum however, please know that there will be detours and inconveniences until the work is complete. Our apologies in advance for disruptions but we believe you will be very happy with the road work once it is complete.
