RESOLUTION 751-2021B

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON ANNEXATION OF PARC AT ESCONDIDO/WEICHOLD ROAD AREAS HELD ON THE MAY 1, 2021 UNIFORM ELECTION DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Converse called for a Special Election on Annexation of Parc at Escondido/Weichold Road Areas that was held on the May 1, 2021 Uniform Election Date for the purpose of placing a proposition on the ballot to annex 213.28 acres known as the Parc at Escondido/Weichold Road Areas; and

WHEREAS, said Election was duly and legally held in conformity with the Election Laws of the State of Texas; contracting with Bexar County Elections Administrator, the results of said Election were verified and returned by the proper judges and clerks; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of at least two members of the City Council is present to duly Canvass the Election Returns of the City of Converse Special Election on the Annexation of Parc at Escondido/Weichold Road Areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONVERSE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Resolution are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Official Canvass of the Returns of the Special Election on Annexation of Parc at Escondido/Weichold Road Areas held on May 1, 2021 reflects the following Propositions received the number of FOR votes and AGAINST votes respective to that proposition:

- A. Approving the Annexation by the City of Converse, Texas of Areas commonly known as the Parc at Escondido/Weichold Road.
