
The City of Converse is proud to announce that the start of a construction street project that officially kicked off and will vastly improve Rocket Lane and our community. The project will last approximately 18-months from now and will extend through Schaefer Rd. from Loop 1604 to FM 1516. This much needed project will improve both vehicle and pedestrian traffic and work to support growth within the City of Converse.

Teamwork and transparent communication are essential to the success of any large construction project. Our team has and continues to work diligently with the selected Contractor to provide the most efficient schedule for all work that reduces the impact on all stakeholders. We are communicating with our partners at Judson Independent School District, nearby businesses and homeowners and various utility services to ensure the project runs as smoothly as possible. The safety of everyone during construction is paramount, as well as ensuring limited impact on utility services, schools and businesses. We will be sharing information on our City website and through various social media outlets and visiting nearby residents in-person throughout the project and make ourselves available to answer any questions or concerns that you may have.

There are four phases of this project, the first phase of this project will extend from Loop 1604 to Judson Middle School which will most notably impact the Northern driveway of Judson Middle School on Monday, September 26th, 2022. During this time, a temporary driveway will be constructed adjacent to this driveway entrance, then the Southern driveway will be closed, and traffic rerouted so that the Northern section can be completed. At no time will both entrances be closed. Pedestrian traffic to and from the schools is not scheduled to be impacted until the summer months, and then new sidewalks currently scheduled to be ready prior to the start of the new school year. This of course is pending weather, supply chain interruptions or any other challenges that can come up during a large construction project.

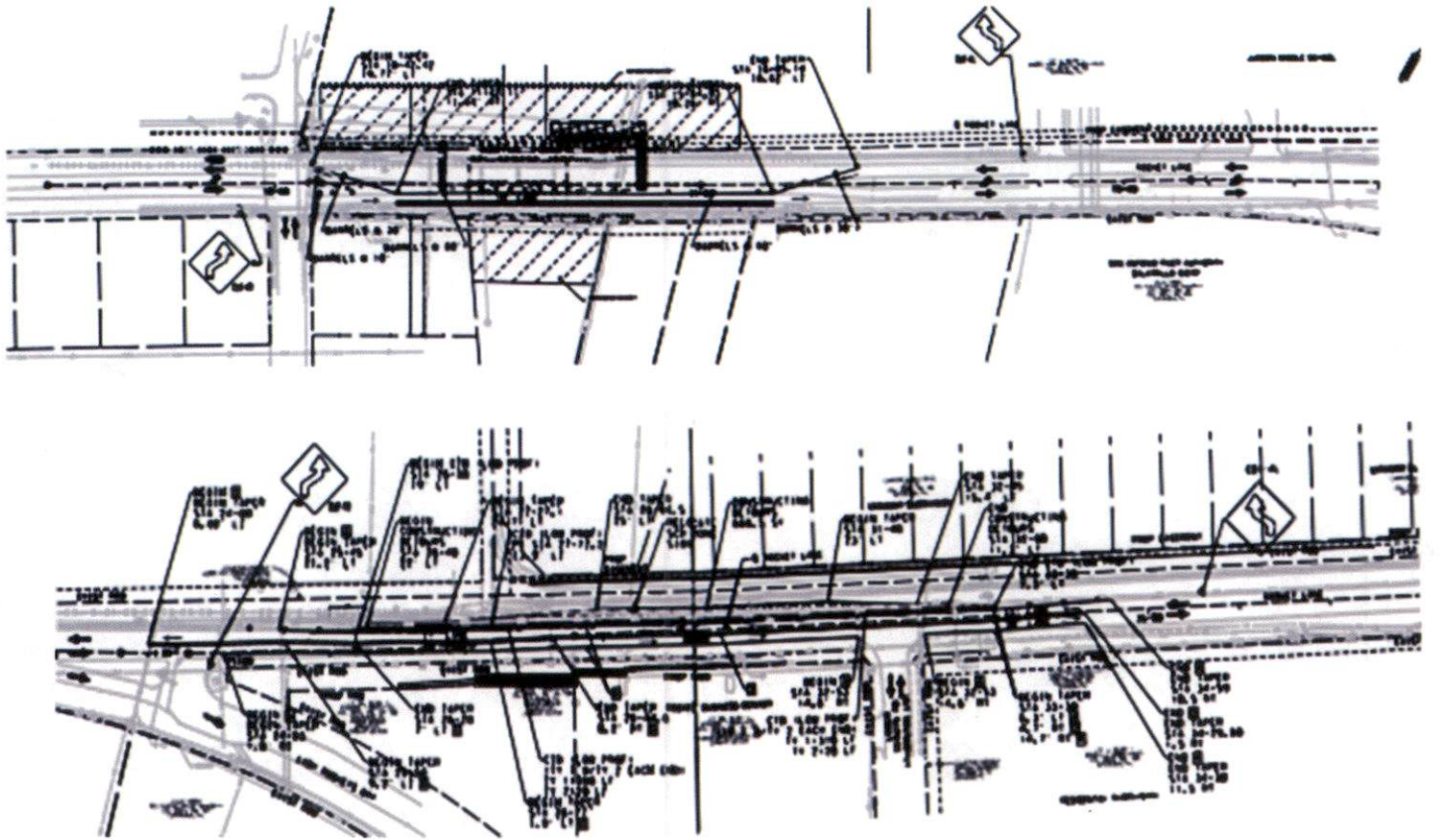
